Copies of the reference cited, together with enclosures thereto, are communicated herewith to the Collectors & District Election Officers, Nizamabad and Kamareddy districts. They are informed that the Election Commission of India has announced Bye-Election to the Telangana State Legislative Council from Nizamabad Local Authorities Constituency of Telangana State, the notification of which will be published on 12th March, 2020.

2. The Commission has stated that the Model Code of Conduct shall come into force with immediate effect in the Districts from the date of announcement *i.e.* from 05.03.2020 in which the concerned Constituency going for Bye-Election is included, and the Model Code of Conduct shall be applicable to all Candidates, Political Parties and the State Governments concerned and further the MCC shall also be applicable to the Union Government in respect of Nizamabad and Kamareddy districts of Telangana State. Hence the Model Code of Conduct has come into force in the entire Nizamabad and kamareddy districts, with immediate effect *ie.*, from **05th March, 2020.**

3. The Collector & District Election Officer, Nizamabad and Kamareddy Districts are requested to intimate the same to all concerned in the districts for strict compliance of the Model Code and take necessary action accordingly.

4. The Collector & District Election Officer, Nizamabad and Kamareddy Districts are also requested to constitute the District MCMC, Flying Squads, Static Surveillance Teams, Accounting Teams, Video Surveillance Teams, Video Viewing Teams, Nodal Officers Model Code of Conduct Teams and other teams required under Compendium of Instructions on Election Expenditure Monitoring immediately for monitoring of election expenditure of the contested candidates and political parties and also furnish the daily reports on seizure of cash, liquor etc., violation of Model Code of Conduct in the **(12)** formats prescribed by the Commission (formats enclosed) by 1.00 pm every day and also furnish the copies of the Teams Constitute to this office.

5. The Collector & District Election Officer, Nizamabad and Kamareddy district, is also requested to communicate these ECI instructions to all concerned in the district and ensure strict compliance.

He is further requested to instruct all the district officials not to address the Chief Electoral Officer directly without notice to the District Election Officer for any clarification/relaxation of MCC. If any relaxation is required the necessary proposal shall be submitted through the District Election Officer with clear request on which instruction of the ECI relaxation is required, full justification for such relaxation and necessary recommendation of the District Election Officer. Deviation of these instructions by any of the district official will be viewed seriously.
