The attention of the District Election Officers & Returning Officers for the Graduates' & Teachers' Constituencies is invited to the reference cited (copy enclosed) and they are requested to follow the Commission's instructions issued in the reference cited restricting the number of persons who may accompany the candidate to the chamber of the Returning Officer at the time of filing of nomination paper. It has been suggested that similar restriction in connection with receiving of the certificate of election would be helpful in controlling crowd.

The Commission has considered the matter and has directed that when the candidates come for receiving **Certificate of Election** also, only a maximum of four persons may accompany the candidate to the office of the Returning Officer. A Nodal Police Officer shall also be identified immediately to ensure proper compliance of the aforesaid instruction at each of the relevant location.

They are also requested to brought to the notice of all the concerned including candidates for strict compliance.
