ORDER:

Under Section 28 (A) of the Representation of the People Act, 1951, the Government of Telangana hereby designate the following Police Officers in the State of Telangana for the purpose of Law & Order and other duties connected with conduct of the ensuing Biennial Elections to Telangana Legislative Council from Mahabubnagar-Rangareddy-Hyderabad Teachers' Constituency, covering the districts of Mahabubnagar, Wanaparthy, Nagarkurnool, Jogulamba Gadwal, Rangareddy, Medchal, Vikarabad and Hyderabad, scheduled to be held on 09.03.2017.

- x) All the Sub-Divisional Police Officers connected to Biennial Elections to Telangana Legislative Council in the districts of Mahabubnagar, Wanaparthy, Nagarkurnool, Jogulamba Gadwal, Rangareddy, Medchal, Vikarabad and Hyderabad.
- xi) All the Inspectors of Police connected to Biennial Elections to Telangana Legislative Council in the districts of Mahabubnagar, Wanaparthy, Nagarkurnool, Jogulamba Gadwal, Rangareddy, Medchal, Vikarabad and Hyderabad.
- xii) All the Sub-Inspectors of Police connected to Biennial Elections to Telangana Legislative Council the districts of Mahabubnagar, Wanaparthy, Nagarkurnool, Jogulamba Gadwal, Rangareddy, Medchal, Vikarabad and Hyderabad.

- xiii) All the Head Constables connected to Biennial Elections to Telangana Legislative Council in the districts of Mahabubnagar, Wanaparthi, Nagarkurnool, Jogulamba Gadwal, Rangareddy, Medchal, Vikarabad and Hyderabad.
- xiv) All the Police Constables connected to Biennial Elections to Telangana Legislative Council in the districts of Mahabubnagar, Wanaparthi, Nagarkurnool, Jogulamba Gadwal, Rangareddy, Medchal, Vikarabad and Hyderabad.
- xv) Any other Police Officers serving for the time being in the Police Department, who are involved in any way in election related arrangements or performing duties in connection with conduct of Biennial Elections to Telangana Legislative Council in the districts of Mahabubnagar, Wanaparthi, Nagarkurnool, Jogulamba Gadwal, Rangareddy, Medchal, Vikarabad and Hyderabad scheduled to be held on 09.03.2017.

2. The above officers are deemed to be on deputation to the Election Commission of India from 13.02.2017 (Date of Notification) to 18.03.2017 (Date before which election shall be completed) or the date of declaration of result of the said election, whichever is earlier and accordingly, they shall, during that period, be subject to the control, superintendence and discipline of the Election Commission of India.

3. The Director General of Police, Telangana, Hyderabad is requested to communicate these orders to all concerned noted under para (1) above and ensure that all the instructions of the Election Commission of India as well as the Chief Electoral Officer are followed scrupulously and to conduct the biennial elections in a free, fair and peaceful manner.
