The attention of the District Election Officers & Collectors of Prakasam, Nellore, Chittoor, Kadapa, Anantapur and Kurnool districts of Andhra Pradesh, Mahabubnagar & Ranga Reddy in Telangana and the Commissioner, GHMC & DEO, Hyderabad and the E.R.Os of Prakasam-Nellore-Chittoor Teachers', Kadapa-Anantapur-Kurnool Teachers' and Mahabubngar-Ranga Reddy-Hyderabad Teachers' Constituencies is invited to the references first to fifth cited and they are informed that certain Teachers' Unions and public representatives have made certain requests and suggestions in connection with the preparation of electoral rolls of Graduates' & Teachers' Constituencies.

State Government notifies the educational institutions within the State and not lower in standard than that of secondary school under section 27(3) (b) of the Representation of the People Act, 1950 with the concurrence of the ECI.

Every teacher who has been engaged in teaching for the qualified period in an educational institution coming up to the prescribed standard will be entitled to be registered as an elector, irrespective of whether he is teaching in the primary section, middle section or any other section of the institution. It is also immaterial whether the person is Secondary Grade Teacher or School Asst., or with any other designation.

2.They have stated that it has come to notice that enrolment is being taken up based on the residence and teachers working in Nalgonda. Medak. Warangal district and who have permanent residence Hyderabad are being provided voting right. Requested to provide voting right to the teachers working in the jurisdiction of Hyderabad, RR Mahabubnagar districts only

To enroll as elector Teachers' Constituency of Legislative Council, a person shall have been engaged in teaching, within the six years immediately before the qualifying date i.e., 1st November, 2016, for a total period of three years in any of the institutions, which have been specified and the person concerned is ordinarily resident within the territorial extent of the Teachers' Constituency in which he seeks enrolment.

It is not necessary that the education institution in which an eligible elector is employed should also fall within the same constituency. The eligibility to be enrolled in a particular constituency shall be determined

			with reference to his place of ordinary residence and not the place of work.
