- (c) the 18th March, 2020 (Wednesday), as the last date for the withdrawal of candidatures;
- (d) the 26th March, 2020 (Thursday), as the date on which a poll shall, if necessary, be taken, and
- (e) the 30th March, 2020 (Monday), as the date before which the election shall be completed; and
- (B) fixes the hours from 09:00 am to 04:00 pm, as the hours during which the poll shall, if necessary, be taken in all the above mentioned States on the date specified above for the election.
