The Election Commission of India has announced the Special Summary Revision of Photo Electoral Rolls w.r.t. 01.01.2023 as the qualifying date and the following schedule has been fixed for taking up the SSR, 2023 in Telangana State.

- Consequent upon amendment in Section 14 of Representation of the People Act, 1950. The Election Commission of India has come-up with four qualifying dates, viz., 1st January, 1st April, 1st July & 1st October of every year. Henceforth Revision of electoral roll will be conducted w.r.t. 01.01.2023 as qualifying date, with three subsequent qualifying dates i.e. 01st April, 01st July and 01st October of the year in which the final publication of electoral roll is done. Whereas, citizens who will attain 18 years of age as on 1st of April, July & October, 2023 can submit their claims in Form-6, in advance beginning from the date of draft publication of electoral roll i.e., 09.11.2022 (Wednesday). These forms/claims w.r.t. (3) subsequent qualifying dates of the year, received in advance, during the SSR period and continuous updation thereafter shall be processed by the EROs under continuous updation during the relevant quarter, preferably in the first month of the quarter.
- 3. All the electors / citizens are requested to extend their cooperation to the Booth Level Officer (BLO) during the special summary revision. All the electors / eligible citizens who will attain 18 years of age as on 01.01.2023 can file their applications for enrolment, objections and correction upto 08.12.2022, and the electors / eligible citizens who will attain 18 years of age during (3) subsequent qualifying dates i.e., 1st of April, July & October of the year, 2023 can submit their claims in Form-6, in advance beginning from 09.11.2022 (Wednesday). While filling their applications, all the citizens / electors shall provide the information accurately in all the columns of the relevant Form-6, 7 & 8 as the case may be. All such applications can also be filed online in the website http://www.nvsp.in
