

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Madam/Sir,

I am directed to invite your attention to the Schedule of Elections announced vide Press Note No. ECI/PN/316/2025 and ECI/PN/317/2025 dated 06.10.2025 (copy enclosed). As you are aware that ENCORE is used for counting during the elections, it is important that the **end-to-end process** is followed in the application to ensure a single source of truth.

2. To familiarize the officials with end-to-end Counting procedure, trainings through VC will be provided to the team of CEOs, DEOs, ROs and technical resources regarding the counting process. Similarly, for testing of the counting process a demo server will be provided in order to self-practice/test the counting process.

- **3**. For the testing on the demo server, the dummy candidate details will be populated and the RO's team appointed for counting can do the hands-on as many times as they require.
- **4**. This is for internal testing purposes, the CEOs should ensure strictly that the data entered or the screenshots are not to be shared with any unauthorized person and users should get access only on a need-to-know basis.
- **5**. Further, all Counting centers should have a complete IT system like computers, printers, scanners, high-speed internet min 8 mbps with redundancy for everything. Returning Officers must be thoroughly trained and supported by reliable IT & NIC staff. The name, designation and mobile number of RO and Technical staff should be readily available. There should be power backup of 15 hours or more, online UPS system and security provisions in the Encore Room with restricted entry. CEO / DEO / RO should satisfy themselves that there is adequate infrastructure & safety.
- 6. It shall also be ensured that all the soft and the hard copies taken during testing must be destroyed immediately after completion. A certificate in this regard should be obtained from all the ROs with regard to successful completion. The Complete details and Roadmap for testing is in Annexure-I.

Sir,

I am directed to enclose herewith the Election Commission's Direction dated 7<sup>th</sup> October, 2025 regarding use of Electronic Voting Machines (EVM) and Voter Verifiable Paper Audit Trail(VVPAT) at the current general election to the Legislative Assembly of Bihar and bye-elections to 8 Assembly Constituencies of 7 States (as per annexure). The Direction may be published in the Official Gazette of the State immediately.

2. I am further directed to invite your attention to the Rules 49A (Design of electronic voting machine), 49B (Preparation of voting machine by the Returning Officer), 49P (Tendered votes) and 49T(2) (Sealing of voting machine after poll) of the Conduct of Elections Rules, 1961, relating to the design of electronic voting machines, form and language(s) of the ballot paper on the balloting unit, design and language of tendered ballot paper and the manner of sealing of voting machines after the poll. The related instructions in this regard contained in the chapter on 'Postal Ballot Papers and Ballot Papers for EVM', in the latest version of the Handbook for Returning Officer, 2023 may kindly be followed. Attention is also invited to the instructions regarding use of VVPAT system and sealing of the paper slips after counting is completed.

3. The above mentioned instructions may be brought to the notice of the Returning Officers of the constituencies concerned for their information and compliance.

4. The aforesaid decision of the Commission may also be given wide publicity.

5. As regards counting of votes, your attention is invited to the provisions of Rules 50 to 54A, 60 to 66A and 55C to 57C of the Conduct of Elections Rules, 1961, and also the Commission's detailed directions and instructions relating to "Counting of Votes" as contained in the Handbook for Returning Officer, 2023 and subsequent instructions issued on the subject, from time to time. The Returning Officers should be instructed to follow the said directions and instructions scrupulously.

6. Kindly acknowledge receipt and confirm action taken.

#### DIRECTION

Whereas, Section 61A of the Representation of the People Act, 1951, provides that the giving and recording of votes by voting machines in such manner as may be prescribed, may be adopted in such constituency or constituencies as the Election Commission of India may, having regard to the circumstances of each case, specify; and

- 2. Whereas, as per the proviso to Rule 49A of the Conduct of Elections Rules, 1961, a printer with a drop box of such design, as may be approved by the Election Commission of India, may also be attached to voting machine for printing a paper trail of the vote, in such constituency or constituencies or parts thereof as the Election Commission of India may direct; and
- 3. Whereas, the Election Commission has considered the circumstances in current general election to the Legislative Assembly of Bihar and bye election to 8 Assembly Constituencies of 7 States (as per annexure) announced vide the Election Commission's Press Notes No. ECI/PN/316/2025 and ECI/PN/317/2025 both dated 06<sup>th</sup> October, 2025, and is satisfied that sufficient number of Electronic Voting Machines (EVMs) and Printers for printing Paper Trail [Voter Verifiable Paper Audit Trail(VVPAT)] are available for taking the poll in the above said Assembly Constituencies. The polling personnel are well trained in efficient handling of EVMs and 'VVPAT Printers' and the electors are also fully conversant with the operation of the EVMs and the VVPAT Printers;
- 4. Now, therefore, the Election Commission of India, in exercise of its powers under the said Section 61A of the Representation of the People Act, 1951, and Rule 49A of the Conduct of Elections Rules, 1961, hereby specifies all the Assembly Constituencies in Bihar and 8 Assembly Constituencies of 7 States (as per annexure) to be notified on 10.10.2025 and 13.10.2025, as the constituencies in which the votes, shall be given and recorded by means of EVMs and VVPAT printers in the manner prescribed, under the Conduct of Elections Rules, 1961, and the supplementary instructions issued by the Election Commission from time to time on the subject.

5. The Election Commission also hereby approves the design of EVMs and VVPAT Printers as developed by the Bharat Electronics Ltd., Bangalore and Electronics Corporation of India Ltd., Hyderabad, which shall be attached to the said machines, to be used for the giving and recording of votes in all the Constituencies.
