Sir,

I am directed to state that the applications of the following one registered unrecognized political party for concession in the allotment of a common symbol to its candidates being set up at the forthcoming General Election to the Lok Sabha in the state of Andhra Pradesh under the provisions of para 10B of the Election Symbols (Reservation and Allotment) Order, 1968, have been accepted by the Commission. Accordingly, the Commission has decided to extend the concession sought under Para 10B to candidates of the said party for the forthcoming General Election to Lok Sabha, 2014, in the state of Andhra Pradesh, in the constituencies mentioned under:-

Sl. No.	Name of the Party	No. of Parliamentary constituencies	Common Symbol allotted.
1.	B.C. Bharat Desam Party	In all the 42 (forty two) Parliamentary Constituencies of Andhra Pradesh.	<b><u>Candles</u></b>

2. The Returning Officers of the above mentioned Parliamentary Constituencies, be directed to allot the common symbol mentioned above to the candidates set up by the aforesaid registered un-recognised political party, subject to fulfillment of the provisions of Para 13 of the Election Symbols (Reservation and Allotment) Order, 1968 relating to setting up of candidates by the party. It may also be noted that said common symbol

allotted to the candidates of the above mentioned political party, is not allotted by oversight to any other candidate in these constituencies. However, the said symbol shall be available for allotment as free symbol to other candidates in all other constituencies, and in the constituencies where the aforesaid party does not actually set up its candidates.

3. In the event of the above said party failing to meet the requirement of the minimum number of candidates, as prescribed in Para 10B of the said Symbols Order, 1968, i.e., 10% of total number of Parliamentary Constituencies in the concerned State/UT subject to a minimum of two constituencies in States having less than twenty parliamentary constituencies allotted to the State (except the States having only one seat), in which it seeks allotment of a common symbol to its candidates, then the said common symbol shall not be available to its candidates.

The Returning Officers of the above mentioned Assembly Constituencies, be directed to allot the common symbol mentioned above to the candidates set up by the aforesaid registered un-recognised political party, subject to fulfillment of the provisions of Para 13 of the Election Symbols (Reservation and Allotment) Order, 1968 relating to setting up of

candidates by the party. It may also be noted that said common symbol allotted to the candidates of the above mentioned political party, is not allotted by oversight to any other candidate in these constituencies. However, the said symbol shall be available for allotment as free symbol to other candidates in all other constituencies, and in the constituencies where the aforesaid party does not actually set up its candidates.

3. In the event of the above said party failing to meet the requirement of the minimum number of candidates, as prescribed in Para 10B of the said Symbols Order, 1968, i.e., 10% of total number of Assembly Constituencies in the concerned State, then the said common symbol shall not be available to its candidates.
