

TRS Manifesto, 2018 Elections

My Whole hearted Salutations to the Telangana People

The state of Telangana was formed following a relentless struggle by its people under the leadership of Telangana Rashtra Samithi. The TRS party united all the Telangana People and sustained the separate statehood movement for fourteen long years. In the process, they faced several hardships and made innumerable sacrifices. The people of Telangana always held in high esteem, the commitment and fighting spirit exhibited by the leader of the movement Kalvakuntla Chandrashekar Rao. His sacrifice included even risking his life. Entrusting the responsibility of governing and developing the state to KCR, the people gave a decisive mandate to TRS in the 2014 general elections. The TRS Government that was formed with all your blessings, commenced the reconstruction process of the state reflecting the aspirations of people at large. During a four and a half years journey an unprecedented progress and development has been registered in the state, attracting the attention of the entire country. The untold misery and destruction of resources and culture during the erstwhile united state leaving behind many a issues were tackled one after another. In the process, the Party gained the renewed confidence of people.

Conspiracies to make it a failed state

The same forces that endeavoured to stop the formation of Telangana State, conspired even after its formation in its sustenance. Before the state could overcome its teething troubles, conspiracies were hatched to overthrow the newly formed government. The electricity power quota which was our right in accordance with the provisions of State Reorganization Act was denied to us. The bifurcation of public sector undertakings and that of High Court was stalled. In spite of several requests and reminders to the central government on this issue, the centre did not cooperate. Desperate attempts were made to prove that the formation of Telangana was a disastrous experiment. Against this background and circumstances, the vision and direction exhibited by KCR as Chief Minister of Telangana, as well as his strategic approach to issues and determination of Governance, the state by overcoming

all the hurdles marched and surged forward in the development direction. As a state, Telangana stands now as a role model in the entire country.

Towards developmental journey, while overcoming impediments...

Historically, the present Telangana was never a state before. And hence, there was no possibility of having a clear-cut understanding about the state finances. Additionally, there was inordinate delay in allocation of All India Service Officers. Despite being engrossed with so many un-favourable hitches and glitches, KCR with his capacity of governance and strategic approach heralded the state towards progress on developmental trajectory. While on hand action was initiated for immediate and urgent needs of people, on the other, the Government, had set before it the long term goals and accordingly moved forward.

The strategy adopted by the Government was successful. The fruits of development and welfare have reached people. In the very first step, the severe power crisis was a big challenge. During the erstwhile united rule, the electric motors, transformers have been burnt, threat of life to farmers when they go for switching the power during mid nights, non-availability of power when required at the time of harvest resulting in loss of crops and the like had totally destroyed the agricultural sector beyond repair. Immediately after TRS Government was formed, the power crisis was successfully handled and successfully tackled. The farmer have become very happy. The industrial sector, due to uninterrupted power supply gas got re-energized. The industrial labour has handful of work. For those who wanted to establish new industries have gained confidence.

Golden era in welfare

TRS Government gave top priority for comprehensive welfare measures. A golden era has dawned in welfare. Livelihood and security has been provided to over 40 lakh poor through Aasara Pensions which included old aged people, single women, beedi workers, filarial patients etc. Kalyana Laxmi and Shaadi Mubarak schemes which have been initiated and implemented to financially help the families of those who sink in severe debts due to marriage

of their girl child, have been yielding excellent results. For providing food security to all the people, the Government, at the rate of one Rupee a kilogram, has been providing six kgs of rice to each person in the family without any ceiling on family size. All the students are provided food with fine rice. The brewing and marketing of illicit country liquor (Gudumba) that brought untold miseries among the lives of rural people in general and Tribals in particular, has been completely stopped by the Government successfully. Now peace prevails in their family lives. In provision of housing for poor the previous governments exhibited callousness. With a view to protect and enable poor to live with dignity and self-respect, the TRS Government has initiated and implementing the construction of two-bed room houses. The design and construction of these houses is such that they will sustain for use for at least two generations. The SC, ST special development Act was enacted to allocate funds to them in proportion to SC and ST population. For the welfare of minorities, in a manner in which no other state did, the TRS government has allocated Rs. 2000 crores per annum.

Restoration of Agriculture sector

Several steps initiated by TRS Government to restore and revitalize agriculture sector which was totally subjected to destruction during the erstwhile rule yielded very good results. All the farmers experienced great relief. Government in addition to providing round the clock 24 hour free and quality power supply has also been supplying on time fertilizers, pesticides and seed. To arrest sale of spurious seeds and fertilizers, stringent measures have been taken by government.

The Rythu Bandhu Scheme introduced by the TRS Government aimed at investment support for each farmer for agriculture with a view that the he need not approach anyone for loans has won the praise from all over the world. The farmers are happy as they are getting Rs 8000 per acre for two crops, at the rate of Rs 4000 per acre per crop. The rectification and purification of land records with an objective to cleanse the entire land records is a great reform in the country. With this a clarity regarding the ownership of land could be arrived at. The Pattaadar Passbooks of the land owner has reached the farmer without his being going around the government offices.

The Government has introduced the Rythu Bhima Life Insurance Scheme to come to the rescue of the farmer's family in the event of his death, for whatever reason it might be. Under this scheme, the farmer's family gets Rs 5 Lakhs from LIC within 10 days of his death. For strengthening the department of agriculture for every 5000 acres, one agriculture extension officer has been appointed. For providing a platform for farmers to discuss among themselves the Rythu Vedikas are being established.

The Government has decided to divide the state into various crop colonies. The farmer is educated to prefer a particular crop in accordance with the geo climatic and soil conditions of the land. Rythu Samanvaya Samithis (Farmer Coordination Committees) have been formed to bring farmer into an organized sector. From initial ploughing till the farmer gets crop on hand and markets them for a minimum support price, the Samithis help the farmer and assist him in all aspects.

TRS Government will be implementing yet another initiative for provision of support price to the farmer for his crop. All over the state, food processing units will be established and the responsibility to administer and manage them will be entrusted to women self-help groups. The food products that are produced by these units will be supplied through public distribution system.

Projects on fast-track

For provision of irrigated water to one crore acres of land, TRS Government has constructed on war footing Palamoor-Rangareddy, Kaleshwaram, Seetarama, Dindi etc. Projects. Parallelly, all the pending projects were expedited on fast track and they are providing irrigated water for 12 lakh acres of fresh ayacut. Thousands of chain of Tanks were rejuvenated as part of Mission Kakatiya. To permanently solve the drinking water problem, the Mission Bhagiratha Scheme has been taken-up. The scheme aims at providing pure and quality drinking water to each and every household through pipes and has nearly been completed. The Mission Bhagiratha scheme has become a role model to other states.

Revitalization of Rural Economy

Revitalization and strengthening of rural economy as well as encouragement of allied sectors of agriculture has also been taken

up by TRS Government. Sheep distribution on a large scale to Yadavas and Kurumas has been going on to strengthen them financially and also to register self-sufficiency in meat production. To enhance the livelihood opportunities of fishermen, the Government has taken-up large scale fish seeding in all water bodies in the state and the rights on fishing there have been given to fishermen. To help and assist the handloom workers, they are provided with continuous work, besides subsidizing on wool and chemicals.

The Toddy Shops in Hyderabad City have been revived and thereby the rights of Gouda Brethren are protected. The tax on Toddy trees has been permanently done away with, giving a great relief to Goudas. The Toddy and palm trees are being grown on a large scale all over the state.

The hereditary and traditional professions of Vishwakarma, Rajakas, Nayee Brahmins are encouraged financially and incentives are given. MBC Corporation was established with Rs 1000 Crores seed capital for the welfare of nomad and most backward castes. Direct loan facility delinking with banks is provided to youth of backward communities for their self-employment.

Education Policy

663 New Residential Schools have been established in the state as part of KG to PG free and compulsory education policy. In these institutions, which are meant for SC, ST, BC and Minorities, the Government spends annually on an average Rs. 1,25,000 on every student. The students receiving education in these institutions have been achieving tremendous results and success in many areas. TRS Government provides overseas scholarship of Rs 20 lakhs per student to those poor students who pursue education abroad. Study circles are established for the benefit of poor to prepare them for various competitive examinations.

Healthy Telangana

TRS Government has significantly developed the Public Health Organization. Facilities were improved in Government Hospitals. Dialysis Diagnostic and Cancer screening centres have been established on a large scale throughout the state. For the benefit of poor patients in the city, Basti Davakhanas are established. For encouraging safe delivery, KCR Kits scheme has been introduced,

additionally, Rs 12000 financial assistance is provided to women delivering in government hospitals to encourage institutional deliveries. If the new born baby happens to be a girl child, an additional Rs. 1000 is given as incentive. For use of mother and child, the KCR health kit with 16 items is given. Kanti-Velugu program has been introduced and being organized successfully, to bring eye screening facility to each and every one suffering from eye related problems in the state. After, free eye screening, medicines and free spectacles are being provided to whoever may require them. Surgical treatment is also provided, when necessary. Free transport vehicles are provided for the last journey of those who expire in government hospitals to take the dead bodies to their respective homes.

Welfare of Employees

TRS Government has enhanced the salaries of government employees by 43%. Telangana increment was also given. The medical expenses of employees are also born by government through introducing health cards. The new zonal system has been created to safeguard the interests and rights of locals in recruitment to government jobs. Exercise is on for fresh recruitment to jobs through the new zonal system. Emoluments of Anganwadi, Asha workers, Home guards, IKP employees, contract employees, Outsourcing employees, VAOs, VROs, sanitary staff and other small wage earners were enhanced substantially.

Comprehensive Administrative Reforms

Comprehensive Administrative Reforms were initiated to bring administration closer to people. 21 New Districts, 26 New Divisions, 126 New Mandals, 75 New Municipalities and 4388 New Gram Panchayats have been created. The long standing desire of Tribals to recognise their Thandas and Gudems as Gram Panchayats have also been realised by the Government. By this act, in 3042 Gram Panchayats, ST brothers will become sarpanches. In Police department also reforms were implemented and 7 new police Commissionerates, 24 new divisions and 102 new police stations were created.

Industrial Development

For rapid industrial development of the state, the Government has enacted a new policy called TS IPass. This act

enables to establish new industries by investors in a hassle-free manner for which the required clearances are given within 15 days of application. Due to TS IPass, industries and investments on a large-scale are being attracted, in Telangana State. As on date, 8220 industries were given clearances with an investment of Rs 1.32 Lakhs crores while providing employment opportunities to 2.50 lakhs of individuals. Largescale facilities are provided to develop the state as an IT Hub. Entrepreneurs and seed IT industries are encouraged. The IT Hub has become a role model to other states.

Law and Order

The Law and order situation in the state is being commended by one and all. The SHE Teams provide the much needed security to women on 24X7 basis and have been playing key role towards this.

Literary and cultural Fields

Several measures were initiated and implemented by the TRS Government to spread the culture of Telangana and the world-over. The important festivals of Batukamma and Bonalu are organized officially. New cloths are distributed to the poor on the occasion of Ramzan and Christmas as a symbol of communal harmony. World Telugu Conference was organized in a unique style, with Hyderabad as a platform for focussing upon the importance of Telangana culture, Telugu language and literature globally. Sahitya Academy and Sangeeta Nataka Academy were created. Telugu language teaching has been made compulsory in all educational institutions, up to Tenth Class in the state.

All-round praise and complements from all corners right from UNO to NITI Ayog

Inclusion of Rythu Bandhu and Rythu Bhima Schemes in the list of 10 great unique schemes of United Nations is indeed a rare international appreciation to Telangana State. The recommendation of NITI Ayog that the Mission Kakatiya and Mission Bhagiratha Schemes should be implemented in all the states is yet another appreciation. This has placed Telangana as a model state. Prime Minister of India, several Union Ministers, Ministers from other states and high level official teams have visited Telangana. After studying our schemes, they are planning them to be implemented in their respective arenas. This again is a proud moment for Telangana.

Agriculture Expert Swaminathan, Nobel Laurette Kailash Satyarthi, Water Man of India Rajendra Singh etc., praising Telangana Schemes and that gives immense pleasure to us. Receiving more than 200 awards and rewards nationally and internationally is surely the result of our hard work.

Implementation of new schemes beyond the 2014 election Manifesto

The TRS Government, after implementing all the promises made in its 2014 election manifesto, have implemented several new schemes which were not mentioned in the manifesto. The TRS Party felt that, they were needed by the people, and therefore, were initiated and implanted successfully. These included among others, the Rythu Bandhu, the Rythu Bhima, 24X7 uninterrupted power supply for agriculture, Mission Bhagiratha, Kalyana Lakshmi, Shaadi Mubarak, KCR Kits, Kanti-Velugu etc., all numbering 76 schemes.

Schemes implemented like nowhere in the country

The Telangana State, by implementing several schemes which are not implemented anywhere in the country has become a role model to other states. Investment Support to Farmer, Providing Insurance to farmer with Government support, 24 hour power supply for agriculture, financial assistance for poor girl child marriage, construction of two-bed room house to poor with total government support and free eye-screening are some of them. All the schemes numbering 64 are unique to Telangana and are taken-up nowhere in the country.

Telangana as Number One State

Notwithstanding the fact that Telangana is a new state, it has quickly become number one state in the country in several aspects. In the revenue growth, per capita power consumption, providing more power for agriculture, implementing welfare schemes, construction of irrigation projects, spending more funds for health and education, plantation program, supplying safe drinking water to every household and similar other 20 aspects, Telangana stands first in the country. It is on the very top position in ease of doing business and solar power generation.

Continuation of all the existing schemes

All the schemes that are being implemented in the state have yielded tremendous results. They are directly helping the people.

Every scheme that is under implementation is leaving a rich experience among people. All these schemes have the blessings of all the people. The Telangana State hold its head high with pride before the whole world as a progressive state. TRS Government that came to power after winning the 2018 elections shall continue to implement all the existing schemes extensively, benefiting the people at large.

Multiplying the wealth and distributing amongst people

The Revenue Growth Rate has been substantially increased by TRS Government by due to steady governance and by way of putting an end to corruption. Due to the vision and direction of KCR coupled with corruption free commitment in the system, the wealth has been multiplying. During the first four years, the state has achieved 17.17% annual revenue growth rate. During, 2018-19 financial year, also the growth rate so far stands has grown to 19.83%. Schemes are conceived and implemented keeping in view the growing wealth and need to distribute it amongst people. For sustenance and continuance of this revenue growth it is indispensable that the TRS government comes to power after 2018 elections yet again.

Future Plan

Significant development and welfare schemes that the TRS Government proposes to initiate and implement soon after it comes to power must form a part of this Manifesto. The Manifesto Committee headed by TRS Parliamentary Party Leader Sri K Keshava Rao has considered and scrutinised meticulous care hundreds of proposals that came before it from different sections of people. The committee on that basis, made recommendations, keeping in view the all-round and comprehensive development of Telangana as well as reflecting upon the TRS view point at large. From among them, only the prominent, important and significant proposals are included in the manifesto now. All the other proposals, after studying the pros and cons will be taken-up for implementation.

During the past four and a half years, all the election promises made in the 2014 manifesto were implemented. Though not mentioned in the manifesto, 76 schemes, that were felt necessary in accordance with needs of the people, were also implemented. Similarly, in the coming days, rather than limiting to the promises made now in this manifesto, the government will go beyond and

take into consideration the demands of people for implementation, as per their needs. The TRS future action plan is just not limited to the manifesto promises only. We sincerely make it clear that, in accordance with the aspirations of people, as the time demands, keeping in view the larger interests of people, implementation of new schemes will become a continuous process.

2018 Manifesto.... Important Promises

- 1. All types of Aasara pensions will be enhanced from Rs 1000/-to Rs 2016. The pensions of differently abled persons will be enhanced from Rs 1500/- to Rs 3016/-. The cut-off date for beedi workers PF will be extended to 2018.
- 2. The age eligibility for old age pension will be reduced from 65 to 57 years completed.
- 3. The unemployment allowance of Rs 3016/- will be given.
- 4. While continuing the construction of double bed room houses as per the existing norms, those a poor persons who have own plot and desirous of constructing a house on their own will be provided financial assistance, ranging from Rs 5 lakhs to Rs 6 Lakhs.
- 5. The investment support of Rs 8000 per acre for agriculture to farmer under Rythu Bandhu will be increased to Rs 10000/-per acre.
- 6. Loan waiver to farmers up to Rs 1 lakh will be done.
- 7. Honorarium to members of Rythu Samanvaya Samithis will be given.
- 8. The report of the committee appointed for drafting schemes for the integrated development of SCs and STS will be implemented by the Government.
- 9. Government will continue to press and fight for implementation of 33% reservation to BCs and 33% reservation to women in legislatures.
- 10. The Telangana State Assembly has passed resolution for provision of 12% reservation to STs and 12% reservation to Minorities. For implementing these reservations the Government will continue to fight for their cause with the centre.

- 11. The SC categorization resolution of the Assembly was forwarded to centre. For obtaining centre's nor for this TRS government will continue to fight.
- 12. For change of categories of different castes, all the appeals will be taken into consideration.
- 13. In addition to Reddy and Vaisya Corporation, corporations for the welfare of even other financially backward communities will be established.
- 14. The future TRS Government will sympathetically consider proposals for establishing corporations, based on the demands received from various sections of people.
- 15. Special schemes will be conceived for the welfare and development of poor amongst the forward castes.
- 16. Food processing units will be established across the state. The responsibility of management of these units will be entrusted to IKP employees by making them permanent employees along with women groups. Food products that are totally non-spurious will be marketed through public distribution system.
- 17. On the line of Kanti-Velugu large scale health camps will be organized across the state for rest of diagnostic tests. The health profile of every individual, as well as that of state will be developed.
- 18. Pay scales for government employees will be given appropriately.
- 19. The retirement age of the Government employees will be enhanced from the present 58 to 61. Parallelly, the unemployed youth will be provided with ample opportunities by increasing the recruitment age limit by three more years.
- 20. Special Directorate will be created for pensioners.
- 21. Land disputes of tribal and non-tribal lands in forest areas will be amicably addressed and ownership rights will be conferred. Disputes with reference to Podu Lands will also be addressed as early as possible. They will be given benefits on par with other farmers.
- 22. Steps will be initiated to establish a steel factory in Bayyaram.

- 23. Pattas will be given to those who have constructed houses in Singareni Plots.
- 24. Efforts are in on to transform Hyderabad as a global city. This will be accelerated with more initiatives.
