

- (a) the 31st May, 2022 (Tuesday), as the last date for making nominations;
- (b) the 01st June, 2022 (Wednesday), as the date for the scrutiny of the nominations;
- (c) the 03rd June, 2022 (Friday), as the last date for the withdrawal of candidatures;
- (d) the 10th June, 2022 (Friday), as the date on which a poll shall, if necessary, be taken; and
- (e) the 13th June, 2022 (Monday), as the date before which the election shall be completed; and

(B) fixes the hours from 09:00 am to 04:00 pm, as the hours during which the poll shall, if necessary, be taken in all the above mentioned States on the date specified above for the election.
