Opinion

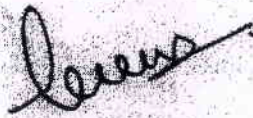

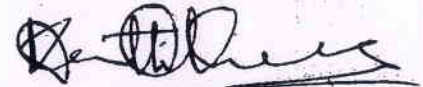

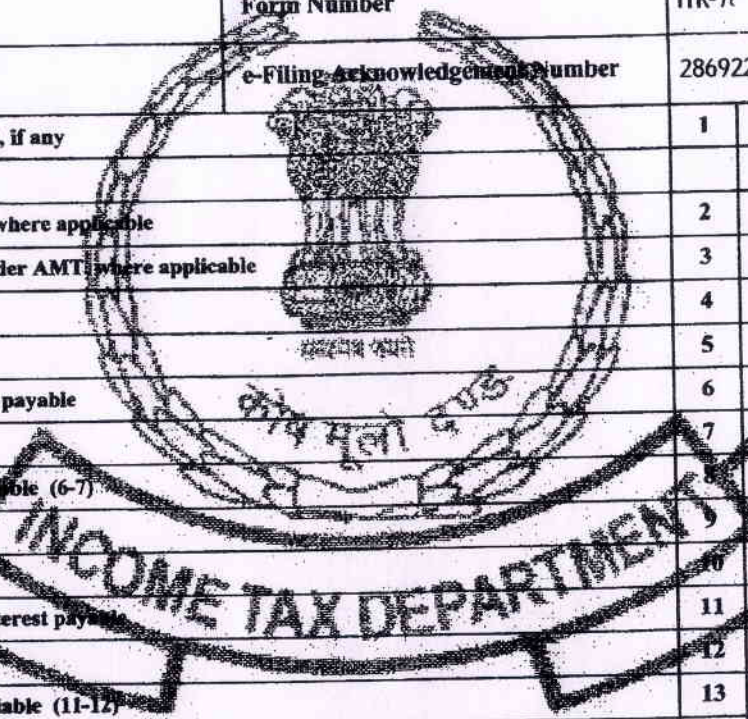
